## REGISTRY TECHNICAL STATEMENT

### 1 Statement of Purpose

- 1.1 To outline the technical policies that organisations need to adhere too to access the Registry systems, both for Authorised Registrar's as well as those with provisional connections.

### 2 Background

- 2.1 This document is a précis of the .NZ Connection Agreement. The Connection Agreement shall be authoritative should any discrepancies occur between this policy document and the Connection Agreement.

### 3 Our Duties

- 3.1 Meet or exceed the agreed level of service between InternetNZ and .nz Registry Services.
- 3.2 Take all reasonable precautions to protect the Registry systems and the data contained in it.
- 3.3 Contact registrars on matters relating to the Registry or other notifications that the General Manager may deem appropriate.

### 4 Your Duties

- 4.1 That any anomaly that is material to the Registry or any other stakeholder is reported to the General Manager in a timely fashion.
- 4.2 To access the Registry for the sole purpose managing the domain names for which you are the designated registrar for.
- 4.3 To prevent unauthorised access to the Registry from your organisation.
- 4.4 To notify the General Manager immediately where the security of your identification and/or Registry access identifier is compromised, or you suspect it may be compromised.
- 4.5 Make sure all information provided to the Registry is accurate and complete to the best of your abilities
- 4.6 Maintain the required equipment and facilities to access the Registry suitable for the volume and level of transitions managed by you.

4.7 To treat the Registry as a key aspect of New Zealand Internet infrastructure and that no unnecessary transaction or event occurs on it.

4.8 At any time at the request of the General Manager you shall be able demonstrate the following:

- Ability to access the system
  - Whois requests
  - Domain name information/ history
  - Check transferred domain names
- Ability to create a record
  - Create a domain name
- Ability to update a record
  - Transfer
  - Cancel and Uncancel a domain name
  - Change registrant contact name
  - Renew a domain name
- Ability to issue a UDAI
  - Validate UDAI
  - Create a new UDAI

4.9 Registrars **MUST NOT** perform any testing on the Production SRS system. The Test system is a copy of the Production system and the Test system **MUST** be used for any registrar testing
